You can follow the complete trail discovering every sculpture (which takes approximately 2 hours at a leisurely pace) or you can choose to explore one of the coloured sections on the map below.

A good place to start is at the Cathedral. However the trail can be enjoyed by starting at any point, following the suggested numbered route or explore as you wish.
